Also present were John P. Barry, Interim-Executive Director; Jacquelyn Carey, Acting Recording Secretary; and staff. Julian Regan and Pamela Dubuc of Segal Marco Advisors were also present.

Interim-Chairperson James Evers presided. Chairperson Evers opened the meeting by wishing everyone a happy Labor Day, noting that it is a very important holiday and a good time for reflection.

He reported that for the month of August, the Fund had a total of \$12,247,940 in deposits and \$18,783,777 in withdrawals for a net-negative of \$6,535,837. He added that the market value at the end of August 2021 was \$1,895,055,719. The Executive Director reviewed the overall performance of each of the Fund's asset classes in comparison to their respective benchmark noting that the hedge fund and diversified beta managers will be conducting portfolio reviews later today.
