d. Report of Executive Director

Chairperson Evers stated that the next item on the Agenda was a report from the Executive Director.

i. General Financial Reports

Mr. Barry directed the Board's attention to the Financial and Flash reports and gave an account of the Fund's financial activities for the month of October 2021. He reported that for the month of October, the Fund had a total of \$18,773,770 in deposits and \$18,923,264 in withdrawals for a net-negative of \$149,495. Mr. Barry commented that the deposits are higher than normal because there were three payroll periods in October. He added that the market value at the end of October 2021 was \$1,912,083,949. The Executive Director reviewed the overall performance of each of the Fund's asset classes in comparison to their respective benchmark noting that the total fund is outperforming both the allocation and policy mix for the year.
